

# Retiree Access to IBM Club Websites


Retirees can be members of local IBM Clubs, but because they are no longer active IBM employees, they do not have access to the Global IBM Club or local IBM Club websites on w3. There is, however, a path for retirees to gain access to the IBM Club websites on w3.

For external (retiree) access to the IBM Club websites, a person must login through IBM.com. To obtain a user ID and password, a registration process is followed. Once registration is complete, the person will be required to logon to access the IBM Club website. This method does not require VPN or direct access to the IBM network.
